

# **Apraxia Speech Toss**

#### **About:**

Our Apraxia Speech Toss game helps children work on articulation. Each mat focuses on the phonological processes of putting together sounds to form simple words. They're perfect for children who struggle with multiple speech errors and have difficulty putting together words. They help your child to articulate, form sounds, and clearly speak. These mats also help with fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination as children toss a ball into teach cup!

## Prep:

• Step 1: Print pages 4-17 in color or pages 18-31 in black and white to color with crayons / markers and laminate the pages.

**Step 2:** Grab small paper drinking cups (like those you use in the bathroom while brushing your teeth), and something to toss into the cups like small balls, pom poms, coins, etc.

Step 3: Enjoy!

### **Directions:**

**Step 1:** Place the mat you would like to complete on the floor or a table. Then place a paper cup on each sun so that you cannot see the picture underneath.

**Step 2:** Stand back and toss a ball into the cup. Try to toss the ball as many times as needed until it lands in a cup. Once it's in a cup, remove that cup from the mat and say the name of the picture underneath with your best speech.

Step 3: Continue to toss the balls into the cups until all of the cups have been remove from the mat.

### **Alternatives:**

If you don't have paper cups, you can toss the pom poms directly on to the mat and say the name of the word they land on. You could also use play dough and smash it onto each sun after you say the word with your best speech.
