




Our Moo, Baa, La La La! Book Companion Rhyming Reader is a speech and language activity for use with *Moo, Baa, La, La, La!* by Sandra Boynton.\* It is intended primarily for young children working on increasing language skills.

Children are fascinated by animals and enjoy imitating animal sounds. This fun and silly book is a great way for children to engage in learning to produce early sounds including, "b" and "m." Combine that with our FREE Moo, Baa, La La La! Book Companion activities, and you've got a fun, easy and powerful way to help children produce some of their first "words." You can choose to practice all animal sounds, or focus on the sound that your child is struggling with.

### Prep:

Step 1: Print pages 5 – 6.

**Step 2:** Fold both pages in half. We like to apply glue between the half folded pages, but this is optional. Fold again into quarters, with pages 1 and 5 in the front. Staple the two folded pages together with the page numbers in order consecutively to create an 8 page rhyming booklet.

Step 1: Read together, practice sounds, color the pages and have fun!

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
