Prep:

Step 1: Print the Easter egg template on page 4.

Step 2: Gather scissors, markers and a spray bottle.

Directions:

Step 1: Color directly onto the plastic tray with markers. Make sure you cover enough surface so it's the size of the Easter egg template.

Step 2: Hold the spray bottle high over the plastic tray and lightly spray the marker ink. You will see it begin to bead.

Step 3: Place the template upside down on the wet marker ink. Lightly push the template onto the ink so it soaks into the entire egg.

Step 4: Let the egg dry and cut it out. Decorate it with sequins or glitter glue if desired.
