







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Final Consonant Deletion Minimal Pairs List

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Help children master final consonants with this Final Consonant Deletion Minimal Pairs List! We start with an 'open word' that ends in a vowel, and then take the same word with a consonant at the end to make a 'closed word'. For example: row + D = road.

Ideas for Use:

Option 1: Say the name of the vowel word followed by the consonant word. Really emphasize the final consonant sound. Ask the child if they can hear the difference. Have them repeat the words.

Option 2: Say the words while clapping. For the vowel word, hold your hands open. This signifies the 'open' sound. For the ending consonant word, clap your hands together. This signifies the 'closed' sound. For example, for 'row', hold your hands apart. Clap them together as you say 'road'.
