





### Prep:

Step 1: Print the shamrock template on page 5 for a 3-leaf clover or page 6 for a 4-leaf clover.

Step 2: Gather scissors, paint, sponges, paintbrush and plate / paint tray.

### Directions:

Step 1: Cover your work surface with newspaper or place the shamrock template on a serving tray for easier cleanup. Squirt different colors of green paint on a paper plate or in a paint tray. If you only have one color of green, you can mix in white paint to make it a lighter color. This will give more variation to your shamrock.

Step 2: Dip your sponge into the green paint and then dab it around your shamrock. You can also paint the shamrock with a paintbrush.

Step 3: Allow the paint to dry and then cut out your shamrock.

Step 4: You could also add glitter or sequins to your shamrock for added fun!
